Virtuozzo Infrastructure Lifecycle Milestones

Phase 1: Mainstream Support

Starts on the general availability date of the major release and lasts until general availability date of next major release. All support services are available during this phase.

Phase 2: Extended Support

Starts when Mainstream Support ceases and lasts for one year. When a product version reaches this phase, no further Updates, Patches or Hotfixes will be created for it (exceptions are possible on a case-by-case basis). If Virtuozzo determines that an issue is fixed in a mainstream version, you will be required to update to it.

Phase 3: Self-Service Support

Available over the course of a product's lifecycle and for seven years after the end of the Extended Support phase. It includes online Knowledge Base articles, FAQs, troubleshooting tools, and other resources to help customers resolve common issues.
